Tying in a (Zippered) Pipe Bag



Tying-in
Groove



1. We are going to fit the stocks into the pipe bag in the order shown here from left to right, Blowpipe stock (shortest), Bass stock (Longest), Tenor stocks (2 The same size), Chanter stock (2nd shortest).

2. Apply a small amount of Vaseline to the pipe bag Blowpipe collar.



3. Place the Blowpipe stock inside the pipe bag under the Blowpipe collar, use a stool or other hard surface to support the bottom of the blowstick stock, grip the collar and push down till the collar clicks into the tying in grove on the stock.



4. Wipe off any excess Vaseline and use electrical tape bind the collar to the stock

5. Repeat steps 2, 3 and 4 with the Bass stock (Make sure that this goes on the same side of the bag as the blowpipe stock) then both Tenors



6. Place the O Ring into the tying in groove on the chanter stock.



7. Place the chanter stock into the pipe bag and tape in place using electrical tape (This will keep the stock in place and help protect the pipe bag from the clamp).

8. Place the clamp over the bump made by the O Ring and tighten (I like to place the clamp so that it faces to the side).



9. Apply TZIP to the zipper, close the zipper, put the blowpipe into the blowpipe stock, insert Stock corks into all the other stocks and inflate the pipe bag.

10. If the pipe bag is airtight cover the chanter clamp with electrical tape, and you are done.
